Please make sure your child is completing the assignments in their Google Classroom and completing 45-minutes of I-Ready Reading and 45-minutes of I-Ready Math each week.

Also, please check the APS website often for the most up to date information from the district. - **School Pictures**

- **Interim Report Cards**

Interim report cards were mailed to your homes on Monday, May 4th so you should have received them by the end of last week. - **Student Pick-up**

Students may tentatively (pending approval) come to Glover next week, May 18 -20. There is a schedule that needs to be followed. You are assigned for pick-up according to the first letter of your last name. Teachers will have students' personal belongings packed in a plastic bag with their name on it. Bags will be in the main hallway. Please follow the schedule below.

- **Kindergarten Registration**

It is time to be thinking of the 2020-2021 school year. Do you have a child that will be five years old by September 30, 2020? It is time to get your child registered for Kindergarten. Registration information is included with the Interim report cards. Even though you cannot physically come into Glover to register, you can register online. Please follow the directions included with the Interim report cards. If you still have questions, please call the APS Engagement Center at (330)761-2810.

- **Chromebooks**

- Access to Chromebooks is essential during these weeks of virtual learning. All Glover students should have their Chromebooks. If you have a locked chromebook, this may have been a technical error, please bring the Chromebook to the nearest high school for repair. If

you did not pick up your Chromebook at Glover it should have been delivered. Please make sure your child charges their Chromebook everyday so they are prepared for their online assignments each day.

- **Contacting Teachers, Counselors, Tutors, Intervention Specialists**

On the Glover website page there is information on how to contact your child's teacher, counselor, tutor, or intervention specialist. It also lists the office hours when you can directly get in contact with the teacher. Please use Remind or Class Dojo or email or texting if you need to reach a Glover staff member. The teachers will be reaching out to you at least once a week but please do not hesitate to contact them with any questions or concerns.

- **APS Food Services:**

- Pickup for food will be Monday through Thursday at the main entrance from 9:30-11:30 a.m.
- Students will receive "To Go" bags for breakfast and lunch every day, and on Thursdays they will be given extra meals to cover Friday. **The Chapel will be providing Bags of Love EACH WEEK on Fridays during the same time frame.** You can just drive up and stay in your car. The food will be brought to your car.

Instruction and Curriculum:

- APS Connected Learning is now online (<https://sites.google.com/apslearns.org/extendedbreakresources/home>). APS Connected Learning lessons for students for home are posted on akronschools.com. Click on the image APS Connected Learning in the middle of the page to find lessons for this week. These lessons will automatically show up on your child's Chromebook when the device is turned on and connected to the internet. We understand that not all students have access to the internet, so we also have paper/pencil instructional materials available during meal pick up times..
- Please have your children check their emails and Google classrooms for more information from their teachers. Students should be completing their I-Ready Math and Reading assignments each day (45 minutes a week in Math and 45 minutes a week in Reading). The current student site on student Chromebooks will be replaced with new information about how your child will connect in Google Classrooms, check emails or use Google Meets to join teachers in real time. Watch the videos along with your student. A family site is also now posted on our Akron Public Schools website with information you need to know in order to help your students. **Students are responsible for completing their I-Ready lessons in Math and Reading AND their Google Classroom assignments from their teachers each week.** We have students that are completing their I-Ready lessons but are not completing the Google Classroom assignments from their teachers. These assignments are being graded and will count for your child's fourth quarter grades.
